

#### Pastor's Note

Sometimes I hear older people say, "I don't know why I am here anymore. I can't get around like I used to. I'm not as fast in my mind as I used to be. I can't contribute anything." This is heartbreaking to hear, mostly because I feel the grief that elderly people feel for the vitality they once had and do not have any more.



Our society values people by what we produce: how much money we can make, what we can make or do for someone else. But is that how God values a person?

We do not value babies according to how much they produce or how much money they

make. (Mind you, they do produce a great deal, just, what they produce don't smell very good!) We don't even value babies by what we think they will produce in the future. We value babies because of what they are. Babies bless the community by being themselves. Just by being themselves, they give us a connection with the future, a hope for new life.

Elderly people are not babies. Not by a long shot. But they are similar to babies in this one respect: Their value and purpose does not depend on what they produce. Like babies, those of us who are elderly bless the community, not by what we can produce, nor even by what we have produced, but rather by what we are. We provide a connection with the past, a depth and wisdom about the present, and a hope for a future of eternal life. Even if we can't get around like we used to or don't think as fast as we once did, these are still powerful gifts.

Whatever your age, please remember God's value for us and God's love, which has come to us in Jesus, surrounds us before we can produce anything, and after we can produce anything; before we make any money, and after we make any money. Christ's love makes us valuable, now and always. Thanks be to God.


#### Hope Buss
