

#### Pastor's Note

You all may recall that in late April, a young man killed five fellow employees and critically wounded a police officer with an AR-15 style rifle at Old National Bank here in Louisville. Ashley, one of our members at St. John, was in the Old National Bank building



at the time. She saw a great deal of blood and the shooter's body as she was being led out by police.

The scene was deeply disturbing, and kept coming up in her mind. However, we believe that God's presence is deeper even than this kind of chaos. So, Ashley

drew a picture of the scene with God's hands around it, and wrote a paragraph into the picture. It was so remarkable I asked her if I could share it and she said "Yes."

Here is what she wrote: God is speaking. "I was everywhere you looked. I held everything in my arms, even the bad things. I hold every scene of your life like this. I cry for you. I cheer you on. I facilitate your healing. Everyone at this scene was in my hands because everyone there was my child. You have questions about the bad things I allow. You won't always find answers, but you'll find me. -God"

This is the kind of community we are. This is the kind of word God speaks through you in this church. Thanks be to God.



#### One Worship Service June, July and August

After several people asked Worship committee to consider one worship service, Worship Committee decided to ask the congregation for input on this question. We provided a survey at worship service and online and a deadline of May 16. 54 of our responses indicated that they thought it was a good idea to try one worship service at 10:00 in June, July and August and 5 indicated that they thought this would not be a good idea. Since so many people responded that it would be a good idea to try one worship service in the summer, council has decided that we will go to one worship service in June, July and August, at 10:00. Sunday Bible Study will be at 9:00, as will choir.

In August, we will survey the congregation again to see whether we think it is a good idea to continue with one worship service at 10:00, or to return to two worship services at 8:45 and 11:00 for September 2023 through May 2024.
