"God's Work. Our Hands" Sunday

"God's Work Our Hands" is Sunday, September 10. We celebrate this with all ELCA congregations every year. This year we are again supporting Street Reach Ministry of Fern Creek United Methodist Church. Their ministry is to personally check on the homeless living on the streets and margins in Louisville. Our task between now and September 10 is to collect non -perishable snacks. Please stop by church and place non-perishable snacks in the boxes beside the front door and the Diehl Hall entrance. On Sunday, September 10, we will assemble the bags for distribution.

Volunteers will be needed September 9 and 10 to organize the food and assemble the bags. Please remember, our donation must be non-perishable and individually wrapped.

Snacks in a Sack Suggestions: Some ideas include Vienna sausages, beef jerky, peanut butter cups (think Jif, not Reese's), Pop Tarts, cereal bars/protein bars, protein drinks (like Boost), applesauce pouches/cups, fruit cups, pudding cups, snack cakes (like Little Debbie's), Rice Krispy bars, chips, crackers, nuts, trail mix, prepackaged ready to eat meals, raisins cookies.

Also needed: gallon sized Ziplock bags, Gatorade and bottled water, and individually

wrapped hand sanitizing wipes. We especially want to emphasize the need for healthy snacks.

Also this year, we are collecting men's and women's socks and underwear to be donated with the food items. Please package or separate the underwear and the socks from the food items as well as the men's and women's clothing items.

Last year St. John's supplied 197 baggies, which were stuffed and distributed to the homeless, and many unfortunate people in the Louisville area. Pastor Darryl Glass of Fern Creek United Methodist Church left a special voicemail for us with a special thank you both the gesture and the overwhelming volume we furnished. Our hope would be to exceed last year's number.


Stephen Ministry
