

Pastor's Note

When I was growing up in Ocean Springs, Mississippi, in the dark of winter, we used to drive on Highway 90 from Biloxi, across the bay, past Ocean Springs beach, past several subdivisions, past the African American section of town, and later on, past our



church till we got home. The African American section had many small, old houses and a few nice, new ones. It held St. Paul's Missionary Baptist Church, where we got barbecue chicken in the summer and where the Rev. Jesse Trotter became the first Black alderman in

the city. It held Jocelyn's Seafood Restaurant, which grew its own mint for its mint juleps in a garden beside the restaurant, and served the best soft-shell crab in the world. It held many small homes, and one shack, where a single man lived, his tiny back yard slam up against the highway. I never knew him. But during Advent every year, he would set out Christmas lights across his home and across his yard, so colorful and so thick that when you drove by it in the winter dark, it looked like a glimpse of heaven.

I wish we could all be like that man. Compared to the powers of brutality and gloom in our world, our lives might seem small, like this man's home. We might feel like only one of a thousand passing, ramshackle structures people drive by every

day. But this man made his home into a testimony, a witness to the angels' light. The carols you sing, the kindness you give, the integrity you follow, the love you share is like that man's light. Small in the eyes of this world, yes, but testifying to triumphant joy.



Thanks for Your Generosity

We weren't sure we could do it, but God did it through us. A group of generous people at St. John set forth a \$20,000 challenge grant, that if we as a congregation could submit 60 new or increased intention of giving cards for 2023, then we would receive an additional \$20,000. It was a significant challenge, but you all came through by the grace of God. We received over 60 new or increased intention of giving cards, with a projected increase of a little over \$800 a week. With this increased income, we plan to hire a technology associate to help with our online presence and worship service, and we plan to hire a new choir director. Thanks be to God!
