other, we also need to take time at Christmas for quiet, for peace, and sometimes for grief.

It is easy to get so wrapped up in our everyday busyness, and now especially our Christmas busyness, that we forget that we are sad, or scared, or lonely. Indeed, sometimes we

use our busyness, whether Christmas or otherwise, to cover up our fear, to numb our sadness.

Strangely, the truth of Christmas meets us exactly in those painful parts of ourselves that we use Christmas to run away from. God comes to us as a light in the darkness, a baby in a manger, a refugee family, a homeless child, us.

That's where God meets us. And because God meets us there, where we are human, we can rejoice even if we are sad. We can sing even if we are lonely. We can have compassion for others even if we aren't doing well ourselves. And if we are doing well, if we are happy, thankful, compassionate, then our joy is even deeper because we know that this is our destiny, this

is the truth beneath all things: ". . . Emmanuel, which means 'God is with us.'" ". . . the Word became flesh and dwelt among us. . ." "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth, peace. . ."
